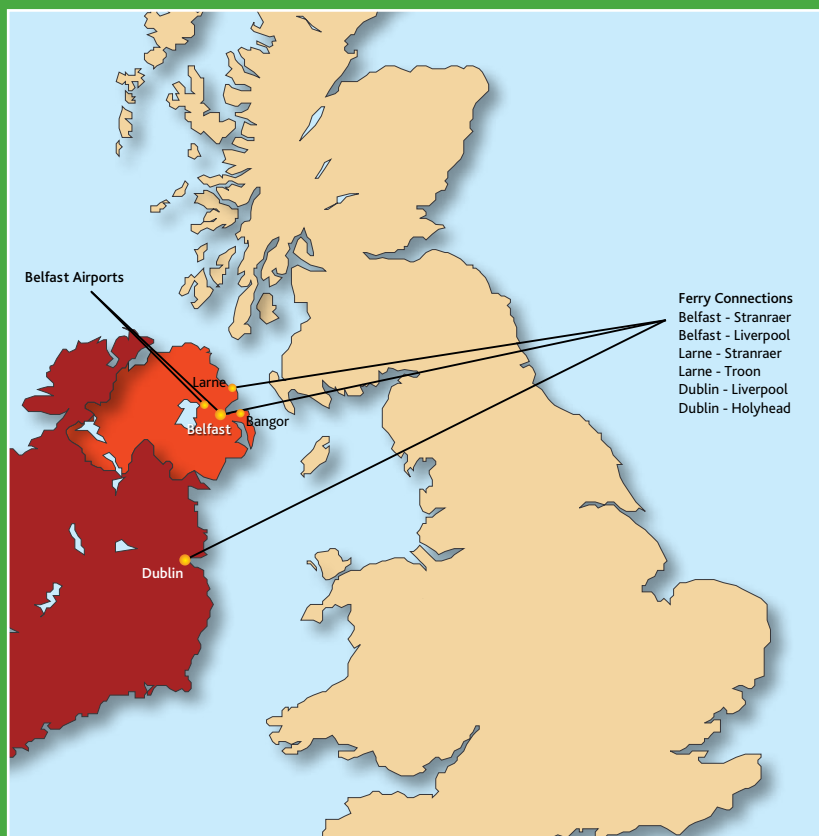


## Eating in North Down
