The Cottages are open everdvav 11:30am-5:30pm until

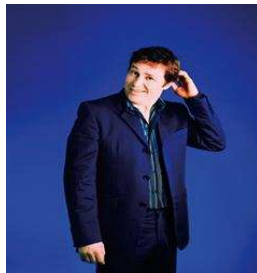


Sunday 5th September.
